I John Hamilton of the county of Adair and State of Kentucky do hereby declare that I enlisted in Continental Line of the Army of the Revolution for and during the war and continued in its service until its termination at which period I was a sergeant in Capt John Smith's Company in the 3<sup>d</sup> Regiment <sup>afterwards called to and</sup> of the Alleganah Line. It was entitled in the Certificate of 808 I am ignorant of it And I further declare that I was not on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 1828 in the Pension List of the United States

Before me Thomas Gilmer a justice of the peace in and for the county of Adair and State of Kentucky personally appeared this day Daniel Coates & John Riggs of the said county who did severally make oath that John Hamilton by whom the foregoing declaration was subscribed is generally reputed and believed to have been a Soldier in the Army of the Revolution in manner as therein stated contents my hand this 5<sup>th</sup> day of January 1829

I John Hamilton aged twenty seven years do upon oath  
testify and declare that I existed in the year 1776 for the period  
of during the war in the Camp being commanded by Capt Smith  
in Third Regiment of the Maryland line of the Army of the  
Revolution and faithfully served to the close of the said war when  
I was regularly discharged at Annapolis in the said State of ~~Maryland~~  
Maryland being then at the time of my discharge in the second  
Maryland Regiment. I do here true declare that I have never  
received a warrant from the United States for the Prauntly and  
due me now have I ever transferred my said warrant to  
any person. Therefore hence witness by these presents that I  
John Hamilton as aforesaid do hereby constitute and appoint  
Henry Ware Trust my true and lawful attorney for me and in  
my name and for my use to ask demand and receive from the same  
Tary of war of the United States a warrant for the Prauntly and due  
me in right of my services as aforesaid and my said attorney  
is hereby authorized to constitute and appoint one or more sub-  
stitutes or attorneys under him for the special purposes above  
named and the same to make at will. In witness whereof
