est from Mr Webb and go by

that and my understanding  
in that was that he was to

pay pay me one hundred  
Dollars a year and the first  
year cover my house and barn  
for \$125 and the rest of the  
rent in money which would  
be 75 Dollars. please pay my  
tax and keep the receipt. I  
have been enjoying my self
