Sally Sanders a resident of this
County of Gallatin and state of Ky aged near
79 years who being duly sworn according to
law made the following declaration in or-
der to obtain the benefit of the act of Congress
Passed July 1836 -

She states and declares that she ~~was~~
~~born~~ from the best information she has that
she will be 79 years of age in August 1837
- that she now lives in Gallatin County Ky
on Eagle creek near the line between Gallatin
County and Owen County. that she was born
in ~~Spain~~ Caroline county Va. and that her
maiden name was Sally Pattie. She states
she was married in the said county of Caro-
line Va. at the house of her father James
Pattie in the month of June 1776. to Nathan
- iet Sanders sent by the Rev Abner Waugh
and that her said husband N. Sanders ~~husb~~
~~and~~ died on the day of Octr 1826. in
the County of Gallatin Ky. She further states
that she has not married since his death
but is still his Widow -

She further states and declares that she
knows but little of the services of her said

husband but is satisfied that he did serve
before their marriage in the War of the Revo-
lution ~~and~~ - She has heard him speak of
the battle of Quebec & the battle of Brimkens
still but she does not know whether he was
in either of the battles. He was according to
his ~~own~~ own act 85 years of age when he
died - She states and declares that not long
after their marriage her said husband in-
-gaged in the service and he was often times
out from the family for months at a time in
the service of his country during said war.
She states that she cannot pretend to say
for her memory is so treacherous that she
cannot rely upon it how many tours of
duty he served during said war or the
length of his tour, but she knows that af-
-ter she was married to him he served
more than two years in said war and
she further states that he was according
to her best information at the siege of
York & Capture of Cornwallis - She fur-
-ther states that she & her said husband
moved to Ky. in very early times and that
her said husband acted as an Indian
spy and Indian fighter for a long time
how long she cannot now say but she
knows for a long time and she has un-
-derstood that his services were of great
benefit to the early settlers of the country

She further states that after their marriage in 1776 her said husband during the revolutionary war did not take time from his services to cultivate a crop and that the main labour devolved on her this declarant. She states that she has no documentary evidence of the services of her husband and that she has now no certain knowledge of any person by whom she can prove them.

~~She further states~~ that she is infirm in body so much so that she cannot at this season of the year attend court.
