General: Hewson notes: "There may have been 10 children, presumably 3 died as infants."

FATHER NOTES: Rev. David Lillard-448

Census (22 August 1850): Birthplace given as Virginia. Living in same household: wife Nancy, Barnetta Dean (F, age 42), Zerelda Castleman (F, age 7), Nancy Hamilton (F, age 70), Mary Hamilton (F, age 68). The Hamiltons may have been related to the husband of his child Narcissa.

General: Death record of son gives birth place as Virginia.

MARRIAGE: RST0004 p. 73 "...David Lillard who had married Mary Spencer, daughter of Col Joseph Spencer, on December 10, 1801". Note on RST0004 p. 72 Col. Joseph D. Spencer, born in Va. in 1739 ... came to Gallatin Co. KY in 1801 David and Mary came to Gallatin Co. in 1804 (p. 73). Therefore David and Mary might have been married in Mercer Co. KY (Harrodsburg).

CHILDREN: Ref 1 gives family structure birth dates for 7 sons with a note on p.296 that there are also three daughters that are not known. Sons listed are: John P. b 1802 [504]; Joseph S. b. 1804 [299]; Rev. James M. b. 1806 [506]; Jeremiah b. 1808 [507]; David S. b. 1810 [508]; William H. b. date not shown [509]; Thomas M. b. 1817 [510]. Note that Artemesia b. date according to IGI is also 1817. Also note that RSTOO4 said that David and wife reared 8 children, this indicates that the 2 daughters other than Artie may not have reached maturity.

DEATH: RST0004 p. 74 "He (David Lillard) preached when he could (after retiring at 72 - abt. 1855), until Jan. 30, 1861 when he passed away at the age of 78.

The Lillards are descendents of Jean (John) Lillard, a French Huhuenot (Protestant) who migrated to America after the signing of the treaty of Nantes in France about 1685. David came to Gallatin Co. abt. 1804. He settled 1 mile from what is now the village of Napoleon. Joined 10 Mile Baptist church in 1806. Ordained to the ministry in 1817. He took over the pastorate of Ten Mile Church in 1817 and served without compensation for 42 years (note that would have been 1857 -- another entry in reports he resigned from active ministerial work in 1854 at (3 years different, but not significant) the age of 72.

David Lillard was also first pastor of Mt Zion Baptist Church (probably in Mt. Zion) which is now in Grant Co. KY. On May 19, 1827, the Mt Zion Church had 19 members. He was the pastor for 29 years (until abt 1856? - this approximates the date he retired from Ten Mile Church). In 1840, he helped organize the New Bethel Baptist Church at Verona (Grant Co. KY) and served as pastor for 20 years (abt 1860). It is said that he baptized about 4000. According to deeds in the Co. Clerks office, David Lillard started buying land in 1844, and continued to buy at intervals until 1856. By that time he had accumulated about 150 acres which evidently adjoined the land he already owned. He owned 30 slaves and success attended him in every thing he did.

His mother died shortly after his birth upon arrival in Harrodsburg, Kentucky.

General: Family records give birth place as Kentucky. Birth place given here is as found in (Gallatin Co. Vital Records) in son's death record (Joseph S. Lillard)

General: IGI PARENTS: Searched for John and John P. with JACK America, no filter; no entry ORDINANCES: submitted 29 Jan 1995.

CHILD NOTES: Capt. Joseph Spencer Lillard-451

General: Grave stone has a masonic emblem and says he was a Captain.

CHILD NOTES: Rev. James M. Lillard-452

General: 0231068, Lillards, David Irvine Lillard, p.14, "Pioneer preacher in NE MO"

James M. Lillard, the eldest son of David Lillard had moved with his wife to Lewis County, Missouri in 1833. He had commenced going forward in public in Kentucky, and was likely licensed to preach by Ten Mile. He soon founded a church in his new home and named it Ten Mile after the one he left in Kentucky. In 1845 he organized the Wyaconda Association, which has become one of the largest and most efficient bodies in Missouri. Elder Lillard founded church after church in this new West, and while his father was at work in Kentucky, he was equally active in Missouri. In 1849 he journeyed to the gold regions of California. Here he dug gold during the week and preached to the miners on Sundays for two years. On returning to Missouri, he continued to work for his Master until he went to his rest, October 10, 1896, aged 90 years. (History of Ten Mile Baptist Church)

General: Leonard Turley gives the death date as 1895, with her husband following a few weeks later. The tombstone transcription gives a date of 1897.

CHILD NOTES: Thomas M. Lillard-456

Birth (about 1820): age 40 in 1860 census

Death (1844): Unlikely given his appearance in 1860 census in Arkansas.

Death (1884): died at home of son, Benjamin Darling Lillard

Med. Note: Inflicted with inflammatory rheumatism.

Rsrch. Note: I found the graves for the family in findagrave.com. They have an extensive history which doesn't match what I already have about him from other sources. (Different wife and parent surnames, for instance.)

Could be the one buried in Ten Mile Cemetery (see General Notes)

Death: Mary is shown in the 1850 census with a daughter, Mary Lillard age 1. If he is the father of this daugher, he must have died no later than 1848

General: Ten Mile Baptist Church Cemetery records show a Capt. Thomas M. Lillard with wife Mary E. Lillard and child Mary T. Lillard.

He was very prominent in Masonic work in Kentucky and was a Knight Templar.
