said service nor have I ever assigned or transferred
said my claim in any manner whatsoever

Therefore I throw all men by these pre-
-sents that I Edmund Compton as aforesaid
do hereby constitute and appoint Joseph Watson
my ~~sole~~ true and lawful attorney for me and
in my name and for my use to ask demand and
receive from the Secretary of war a warrant for
the Quantity of land due me as aforesaid and my
said attorney is hereby authorized and empowered
to constitute and appoint one or more substitutes or
attorneys under him for the special purposes above
named and the same to do he it will - Intending
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal this 6th of December 1824
