W<sup>m</sup> Andersons Will and Testament

First I give and bequeath to my son Wilson G Anderson two thirds of my real estate and he is to take care of the family that is his mothers lifetime

Second I give and bequeath the remainder of my estate to my beloved wife Nancy G Anderson her life at her death the same to my daughter Julia G Anderson

Third I give bequeath to my son Elijah G Anderson fifty dollars this being a half of what he owes me for a mule that I sold to him for one hundred dollars

Fourth, I give and bequeath to my three oldest children Susan M Dexter Sarah C Fanchard & Charity A Stroud to each one dollar a piece, my first wife Charity Anderson made forty acres of land from her fathers estate, which she give bequeathed to my oldest son John G Anderson for which I have made a deed of conveyance according to her order which I promise to do, day and date above to which I affix my hand and seal
