In the name of God amen, I David Jernigan of Muhlenberg
County and State of Kentucky being of sound mind and memory
have thought proper to make this my last will and testament.

1st I give my soul to God who gave it, and my body to the dirt
2^d I desire all just debts to be paid and my body to be decently
buried out of the proceeds of my estate. 3^d I give to Nancy Cham-
berz out of my estate One hundred and fifty dollars 4th I give to
Sarah Bunnely One hundred and twenty dollars. 5th I give to
Mary Diggs Children they being my Grand Children Two hundred
and fifty dollars 6th I give Jane Merril alias Jane Rowk One
hundred and twenty dollars out of my estate, but in the above
bequests I desire Mary Diggs children to receive one hundred
dollars first provided there is not enough of my estate to fill all
the bequests. This is on account of the others having received out of
my estate that amount there for all to share equally alike in
pro rata to the amount if there should be a defisette in my estate
should there be more of my estate than what has been bequeathed the
remainder is to be equally divided between all my children
except Elifal Lambuth. 7th I give and bequeath to Elifal Lambuth
a note I hold on John R. Lambuth for Two hundred dollars to her
and her heirs forever. being all that she is to receive out of my
estate In Witness I have hereunto signed my name this 31st.
