and testament

Having at various times deeded to my six surviving children
certain parcels of land with which they are to be charged
with out interest in the final division of my estate among them
at the prices stated in ^{to their or if not so stated, up to date} the ~~deeds~~ They are to be charged at a fair and
equitable valuation of said lands at the date of said deeds
As an act of justice to, and affection for my beloved wife Susan
A C Oates do hereby make the following bequest in her behalf as fol-
lows, to wit

Item first I will and bequeath to her my said wife all my personal
property of whatever nature embracing house hold and kitchen
furniture farming implements, live stock agricultural and
food supplies, Cash and Cash notes and all other indebtedness
to me whatever.

Item Second I will and bequeath to her my said wife a life estate
in all that portion of my homestead land, not hitherto conveyed
by deeds to various parties, which is fully described in a report
of E M Brank Surveyor and S M Wilkins and W C Martin pro-
cessors for Muhlenberg County which report was filed
in December 1857 and in addition thereto I will and bequeath
to her a life estate in a remnant of a tract of land Conveyed
to one by deed from Hyatt Oates dated 31st day of March 1856

the greater portion I have sold and deeded to CW Coleman
 Item Third I hereby invest my said wife with full powers of attorney
 in fact to sell all or any part of the residue of two tracts of
 land purporting to contain together 150 acres which lands were
 conveyed to me by Robert M Randolph & his wife by deed dated
 the 21st day of June 1852 and this for the purpose of meeting my un-
 paid expenses or my debts up to the time of my death or for debts
 or expenses that may accrue or accrue in consequence of my death
 Item fourth I hereby appoint my wife the said Susan A C Oates sole
 executrix of this my last will and testament and for her to enter
 upon the discharge of this trust without giving bond
 In testimony whereof in presence of the subscribers witness I
 have set my name this nineteenth day of December 1890
