

I Jons Walker being of sound mind And disposing memory do make And declare this my last will And testament First I will And desire that all my just debts And funeral Expenses be paid,

Second I will And bequeath all my personal property to my wife Maranda E Walker during her life time And at her death to descend to my youngest Child Myott W Walker

Third I give And bequeath to my wife Maranda E two tracts of land which constitute the farm One tract Containning 60 acres the Other Containning 31 acres the two tracts Containning 91 acres at the death of my wife Maranda The two tracts to descend to my youngest son Myott W Walker to be owned And possessed by him

Fourth I give And bequeath to my Other Children a tract of land Adjoining the two above tracts Containning 45 acres This tract to be sold And divided ~~between~~ my Older Children

I hereby desire that Myott Johnston be appointed my Executor Witness my hand this 22 day of March 1880
