In the name of God Amen.
I Catharine Edwards of the County of Muhlenberg and
State of Kentucky, being of sound mind and disposing memory,
being in health but calling to mind the uncertainty of life and
the certainty of death, being desirous of disposing of my worldly
affairs, I do make utter publish this as my last will & testament
in the manner following To wit:
Item first, It is my Will that after my decease, that all my
just debts & funeral Expenses be first paid out of my personal Estate.
Item Second, It is my Will and desire that my Son Jonathan
Newell Edwards shall have all my personal & real Estate in
consideration that he shall take care of me during my Natural life.
Item Third, I feel all the Natural love and affections for my daughter
Martha Ann Elizabeth Shutt, that is common for Parents to
have for their children, but she has expressed a willingness that
if my Son Jonathan should remain with me, and take care of
me, that she should receive as a consideration my personal &
real Estate at my death.
