of Ramsey (multenbury) County - Kentucky - in the full
possession, of all the faculties of my mind knowing the
uncertainty of human life at the best, and being now sick
and thinking, it uncertain as to my Recovery, do ordain
this to be my last Will and Testament, hereby Revoking
all other wills gifts &c. heretofore made Except. Such as
are heretofore ~~made~~ - First I give and bequeath to my
dear wife the house and 2 lots, on which I now, live being
numbered in the Plat of Said Town 109 & 110. and my
negro girl Adeline, and all the personal property that
may be Remaining after the payment of my just debts
I give and bequeath to my 2 nephews, James Henry &
Lewis Fletcher Condit, the sons of Wm. Condit, and
my wife, the house and 2 lots - numbered
on the plat of Said Town, 29 & 30. to be sold and
the money arising from the sale thereof to be
Equally divided between them - I hereby appoint
my father, Daniel Lindley, my Executor to carry
into Execution, this my last Will & Testament Ramsey
Sept 9th 1843.
