make ~~my~~ last will and Testament in manner and
form following that is to say

- 1st I desire that all my just debts and funeral expenses be
paid immediately after my decease
- 2 I desire that my son Matthew Nannay have five Dollars
and One hundred acres of land that he now lives on
deeded to him by me to him and his heirs for ever
- 3 I give to my son John Nannay five dollars and fifty acres
land where he lives which I have not deeded to him to him
and his heirs forever
- 4 I give to my daughter Ann Cravens five Dollars to her
and her heirs forever
- 5 I give to my daughter Sally Cain five Dollars to her and her heirs for ever
- 6 I give to my grand daughter Polly ^{for her share} ~~to her~~ ^{to her} her heirs for ever
- 7 All the rest of my estate both real & personal of what nature
~~and kind soever it is~~ may be not herein before particularly
disposed of I give to my son Stephen Nannay to him
and his heirs forever

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son
Stephen Nannay Executor of this my last will and
Testament hereby revoking all other or former wills
or Testaments by me heretofore made in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my Seal this 4th day of February 1854
