 - 5 I give to my daughter Sally Cain five Dollars to her and her heirs for ever
 - 6 I give to my grand daughter Polly ^{five dollars} ~~to her~~ to her heirs for ever
- 7 All the rest of my estate both real & personal of what nature ~~and kind soever it may be not herein before particularly~~ disposed of I give to my son Stephen N Nauney to him and his heirs for ever

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Stephen N Nauney Executor of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other or former wills or testaments by me heretofore made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 4th day of February 1854
