

D. Stanton's
Will

In the name of God Amen — I Dicy Stanton of the County of
 Mchlingburg and State of Kentucky being Sick & weak in Body But of Sound mind
 and disposing memory do make this my last will and Testament Hereby revoking
 all former wills by me made and declaring this to be my last one 1830 I desire
 that all the personal part of my Estate be immediately sold after my decease and
 out of the moneys arising therefrom all my just debts and all funeral Expenses be
 paid and should the perishable part of my Estate prove insufficient for the
 purposes as above named then I desire my Executors hereinafter to collect from
 Mr James Taggart Five Hundred & Six Dollars the Balance of the sum of
 money I placed in his hands to keep for me in the year 1825 or 4 with legal
 interest thereon and out of the moneys arising therefrom pay and satisfy
 such of my just debts as shall remain unpaid out of the perishable part of my
 Estate — & after the payment of my debts and funeral Expenses, I Give
 to my Son Hilary Stanton and his Heirs forever the balance of the sum due from
 said Taggart also all that is due me from the Estate of my Husband Abraham
 Stanton Deed also all the rest of my Estate of what nature or kind it may be
 not herein before particularly named Except one Dollar hereinafter mentioned
 & I Give to my Son John Stanton one Dollar if he be living And Lastly I do
 hereby constitute and appoint my friends Alexander McPherson and Samuel
 Thomas Executors of this my last will and Testament — In witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 14th day of
 March in the year one thousand eight hundred & fifty
 Dicy Stanton
 and declared as a will for
 the last will and Testament
