Item 1st It is my will and desire that all of my just debts and
burial Expenses shall be paid
Item 2nd I desire that my beloved wife Kitty shall have one
third of my landed Estate during her natural life
Item 3rd It is my will and desire that the portion of real Estate
devise to my wife Kitty shall at her death divided equally between
my Daughters Frances and Alice and my Son William
Item 4th It is my will and desire that my Son George and Son
by my former wife Matilda shall have the sum of One Hundred dollars
each after the settlement of all Claims against my Estate
Item 5th It is my will and desire that Emily Culerson daughter of
my wife Kitty by her former husband shall have the sum of Fifty
Dollars paid to her out of my Estate
Item 6th It is my will and desire that the remainder of my
Estate be equally divided between my Son William and
Daughter Frances and Alice my Children by my present
wife Kitty and Peter Tucker son of my wife Kitty by her
former husband that is to say making the last four Children
equal heirs to my Estate remaining in this last Item
