I give & dispose of in the following manner to wit, In the
first place 1st I do give & bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy
Vickers a feather bed & furniture also two Socks & twelve Shirts
also one Cow during her natural life 2nd Also to my
beloved wife Nancy I give & bequeath my Saddle Horse called
Jack after my decease 3rd My old Blacksmith tools I give
to my daughter Nancy 4th To my son Jacob I give \$1 -
5th To my daughter Polly I give \$1.00 6th To my son
Ralph I give \$1 - 7th To my daughter Susan I give \$1 -
8th To my son John I give \$1 - My farming utensils &
other tools I cannot sold to pay of the small legacies
just named I do hereby Revoke all other Wills and
Testaments made by me & do declare this my last
Will & Testament - Also I appoint John Vickers & Jacob
Vickers Executors - In testimony whereof I have here
unto set my hand & affixed my seal this 26th day of
December 1829
