

The last will & testament of Stephen Wilcox I item the 1st I devise that all my just debts be paid & disposed bequeath my I wish Dear
well beloved wife Susan Wilcox to have one hundred & a half of her
own choosing also I bequeath her all my household furniture
including beds & furniture cups and saucers &c also all my kitchen
furniture - I also wish her to have hogs enough to make meat for
her my dear children for 12 months & corn for the length of
a year
Item the 3rd I give to my son David J.
Wilcox all my lands subject to my wife & daughter Right in the
land on which I now live during her life time or under her
Item 4th " I give to my other children to wit, Kitty Ann &
Juley Ann (now it being known that my wife Susan is in a
family way if it should come to live name three in
member) all my property after debts & expenses & articles
above named taken out to be Equally divided now the said
three to wit Kitty Ann Juley Ann & name
Item the 5th I wish all my children Kitty Ann David J.
Juley Ann & name to have good common
schooling out of the proceeds of my property - Item 6th "
I do hereby appoint W^m S. Day ex^r to this my last will
& testament to sell all my loose plunder & pay my debts & then
divide as above named - In testimony whereof I have
here set hand &c at this 1st day of July 1844
