

Leovington Ky June 27 "1883

I Judith A Estill of Leovington Ky being of sound mind and of a disposing memory do make and declare this to be my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other wills.

Item 1st, I direct my Executor first to pay my funeral expenses and all of my just debts.

Item 2^d I give and bequeath to my two Neices, Helen M. and Judith A Rogers, daughters of my brother Augustin Rogers, all of my Silverware to be equally divided between them.

Item 3^d I give and bequeath to my brother, Augustin Rogers, all the property of every kind and character, whether real or mixed that I may die possessed of and also all the interest of every kind and character that I now have or may hereafter have in the estate of my deceased husband (J P Estill) I hereby nominate and appoint my brother Augustin Rogers Executor of this Instrument and ask the Court not to require any bond of him. I hereby empower him to sign all necessary papers and to pass all necessary deeds and hereby give him full power and authority to do so.
