

Declaration, in order to be placed on the Pension List, under the Act of the 18th March, 1818.

On this day of ferree 1828, personally appeared in open court, (a) [being a court of record (b) for the district, circuit, county, or corporation, as the case may be,] County of resident in said county, aged 65 years, who, being first duly sworn according to law, doth, on his oath, make the following declaration, in order to obtain the provision made by the acts of Congress of the 18th March, 1818, and the 1st of May, 1820; that he the said day of in the term of 3 in the State of day of in the company (d) commanded by captain of the last of the regiment commanded by colonel continental in the line of the State of Poury of waren the establishment; that he continued to serve in the said corps (or vessel) until in the State of Carrylines; that he hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension, except the present; that his name is not on the roll of any State, except Accept and that the following are the reasons for not making earlier application for a pension: (e) lat he fatter And, in pursuance of the act of the 1st May, 1820, I do solemnly swear, (or affirm, as the case may be,) that I was a resident citizen of the United States on the 18th day of March, 1818, and that I have not, since that time, by gift, sale, or in any manner disposed of my property, or any part thereof, with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of Congress, entitled "An act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War," passed on the 18th day of March, 1818; and that I have not, nor has any person in trust for me, any property, or securities, contracts, or debts, due to me; nor have I any income, other than what is contained in the schedule hereto annexed, and by me subscribed. (f) That, since the 18th of March, 1818, the following changes have been made in my property. (g) x acces a Z ela ingest. I also certify, that the foregoing oath, (or affirmation,) and the schedule thereto annexed, are truly copied from the records of the said Court; and I do further certify, that it is the opinion of the said Court, that the total amount in value of the property exhibited in the aforesaid schedollars and dule is seventy two In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand, and affixed the seal of the day of June said Court, on this Accound Clerk of the Court of the Scott Circuit Kentucky.
