On the 11th day of January 1863 personally
appeared in open Court before the Justices of the
Court for the County of Hopkins aforesaid some
witness Alexander Hays a resident in said County
thirteen years of age & being duly sworn according to law doth in his oath
make the following declaration in and to the effect
that he entered the service of the United States

under the following named Officer and served
as herein stated

He states that he was born in Philadelphia
County in the State of Pennsylvania
on the 30th day of September 1788 that when
he was about twelve or thirteen years of age
he removed with his father James Hays
to the State of Maryland and settled in
the County of Baltimore in said State where
the Revolution found him that some
time after the commencement of the Revolution
he substituted for his father James Hays
aforesaid in the County of Baltimore aforesaid
for three months under Captain William Wilson
and Jacob Joshua Nelson of the Maryland
militia that he resided at Port
Town in the said County of Baltimore
and was then in the County of Baltimore
when he joined Captain William Wilson

At the same time ~~under~~ ^{under} ~~his~~ ^{his} command
he remained in the City of Baltimore
aforesaid until he was ordered when
he was discharged and returned home
he received no written discharge

He states that from the day of joining
consequent on age and infirmity he can
not state the date of his service

He states that shortly after he returned
from aforesaid he was drafted for
months under Capt Hunt Station aforesaid
and Ensign Benjamin Todd that he
resided in the neighborhood of Long
John aforesaid and marched thence
to the City of Baltimore when he again
joined Colonel Buchanan a Regiment
aforesaid and after serving under his
command one month he was dis-
charged and returned home he
received no written discharge

He states that the Enemy were expected
to attack the City while he was there but
did not do so. He further states that
he saw at Baltimore a Colonel John
Howard but whether he was a Contin-
ent or Militia Officer he does not
remember but he was a soldier that said
Colonel Howard marched with his command
northwardly and in this direction afterwards
