A D One Thousand Eight Hundred &
Sixty Five personally appeared before me
Wm. [unclear] a justice
of the peace within & for the County & state
aforesaid Micherey Lancaster aged about
Sixty two years a resident of the
County & state aforesaid & being first duly
sworn according to law declares & says that she
is the widow of Thomas Lancaster deceased
who was a private soldier in the war of
the Revolution. Her information which she
lives to be correct is that her said husband was
died at the time of the war in the County
of Orange in the state of Virginia
& that he joined the army in or near that section
of Country & served three years & six months some
part of the time stationed at Albemarle Barracks
and was also attached or belonging to a Regiment
commanded by Colonel Allcock she cannot
at this remote date particularize the different
Captains under whom he frequently spoke of serving
nor is she able to state the place & time or times
of being attached & disbanded from the army
her information & recollection is that she saw
various campaigns under different officers the
names though often spoken of by him she cannot recollect
And was horribly discharged at different
places which she ~~now~~ forgot - no papers can now be found
verifying or particularizing his service
on or about the day of
She further states that she
was married to the aforesaid Thomas Lancaster
in the County of Pendleton & state of Kentucky

on or about the 23rd day of November
A.D. 1813. by and David Robertson
a Methodist preacher
& that her name before her said marriage was
Michiey Owens. That her said husband died
in the County of Randolph & State of Kentucky
on or about the 25th day of July
Eighteen hundred & twenty eight & that she is still
a widow & the widow of Thomas Lancaster she
makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining
the bounty land to which she may be entitled
under the act approved March 3rd, 1855. She
also further declares that she has not married
nor herebefore applied for any bounty land
under this or any other act of Congress.
