George Taylor came from Stafford County after the turn of the century (1800) and opened the first school in this settlement. His father, William, had inherited Dr. Robert Taylor's estate. At the death of his father, he went to VA and brought his (William) negroes to KY. He received an annuity from the estate and at his death, the remainder was divided among his children.
