As promised I have taken a second look at the 1880 cenus and there is no William Hall on Page 405B BUT there is a family or two on that page that may well be of interest to you. There is a David Hall, age 27, Emmaline, wife, age 23, with children Martha, age 5, Jesse, age 4, and what looks like Ella but may be Etta, age 2. Page 405B is very faded and it just may be that one can't see the cross of the tts on what look like lls. I tried several times at various settings to print out a copy of the page but it is difficult to get a good readable copy. On the darkest copy, nearly black, it does faintly appear that the name may be Etta.

Also of interest is the fact that immediately below the David Hall entry is a household comprised of William Holland, age 27, and Mary Eliza Holland, age 54. The cenus does not indicate the relationship between the two but most likely Mary Eliza is William's mother. No other people are in the household. I was focusing on the name Hall and did not pick up this information until I again looked at my copies of the page after getting home from the library tonight. Thus, I did not look for other Hollands that might also be neighbors to the David Hall family.

Other than young children, the only entries that I found for William Hall in the 1880 cenus are as follows:

Page 418: William S. Hall, 29, Ella, wife, 23, and children Arthur, 8, Minnie, 4, and Carrie L., 3/12. (Ella's maiden name was Quinlin)

Page 423B William W. Hall, 34, Lizzie, 32, George H. 7, Alfred A, 5, Myrtie, 8, and Jennie B., 9/12. (Lizzie's maiden name was Mains)

Page 358 There was a 10 year old boy, William Hall, enumerated in the household of Armstead Burton, relationship, nephew.

Next I checked the 1910 Pendleton County census and found the family but Anna Hall was now a widow:

Anna B. Hall, Head of Household, age 55, mother of 9 children of whom 7 are living. Anna Hall, Daughter, age 13 Willie Hall, Son, age 10

The Falmouth Outlook began publication in the summer of 1907 and I checked the death index of the paper and found no death listing for David Hall between 1907 and 1911. In the early days of the paper, fewer obituaries were published than in later years, but my guess is that he probably died between 1900 and the summer of 1907. Again, I emphasize this is only a guess. Jerry Pape
