Carey Menzie Yelton

Carey M. Yelton, aged 76 years, passed on suddenly at his home on Barclay street, Tuesday morning, October 1, 1935, following a heart attack. Mr. Yelton had been in poor health for over a year, but his passing came as a shock to his family and friends.

Mr. Yelton was born in Campbell County near Butler on Feb 12, 1859, and was the son of the late Mortimer and Catherine Newkirk Yelton. He followed the vocation of a farmer until a few years ago, when he retired, and he and Mrs. Yelton came to Falmouth to reside.
