*This company was also known as Company D, 30th Regiment Tennessee Infantry.

The 30th Regiment Tennessee Infantry was accepted into service October 22, 1861; surrendered at Ft. Donelson February 16, 1862; was released at Vicksburg, Miss., September 21, 1862; re-organized about September 20, 1862, and declared exchanged at Aiken's Landing, Va., November 10, 1862. It appears to have been consolidated with the 10th Regiment Tennessee Infantry about May, 1863, and in September, 1864, the 2d, 10th, 15th, 20th, 30th and 35th Regiments Tennessee Infantry were consolidated, but each company of the various organizations was mustered separately and under its original designation during the period covered by these consolidations.

About April 3, 1865, the 2d, 3d, 10th, 15th, 18th, 20th, 26th, 30th, 33d, 37th and 45th Regiments and the 23d Battalion Tennessee Infantry were consolidated and formed the 4th Consolidated Regiment Tennessee Infantry, which was paroled at Greensboro, N. C., May 1, 1865.

It appears to have been consolidated with the 10th Regiment Tennessee Infantry about Mar., 1863; and in September, 1863, the 5th, 10th, 15th, 20th, 25th and 30th Regiments Tennessee Infantry were consolidated, but each company of the various organizations was mustered separately and under its original designation during the period covered by these consolidations.

About April 9, 1865, the 5th, 10th, 15th, 20th, 25th, 30th, 35th, 40th and 45th Regiments and the 23d Battalion Tennessee Infantry were consolidated and formed the 4th Consolidated Regiment Tennessee Infantry, which was paroled at Greensboro, N. C., May 1, 1865.
