## Richard Allen of White Oak Creek Land Transactions

Richard Allen's first purchase of land in Morgan County was for 50 acres on Lower (Left Fork) White Oak Creek October 9, 1824. This land was adjacent to Peter Lykins.

Richard had moved to what was Floyd County in 1819 and first lived on Caney Creek near his fatherin-law Elder Daniel Williams. He married Edy Williams January 20, 1820.

Through 1855, Richard bought several additional parcels for a total of 1,104 acres.



The coordinates given in the legal description for Richard's first 50 acres result in this plat when transposed to a modern day topo map.

Richard and Edy are believed to be buried in unmarked graves in the Allen Cemetery. Their descendents still own and live on the property.
